

2023-2024 Scholarship Applications and Information

Scholarship Process

- Applications are submitted and reviewed for Completeness from December to March each year
- A limited number of four-year scholarships are awarded along with one-year scholarships.
- Award recipients will be notified by May each year.
- Scholarship funds are distributed to the awardee's institution for the upcoming academic year.

Application Requirements Criteria

To be eligible for a Navy Supply Corps Foundation Scholarship, the applicant must meet the eligibility criteria below. Acceptable official documents to determine eligibility include DD-214, discharge or reenlistment certificates, current active-duty orders as well as marriage license, birth certificate, or tax documents showing dependency.

To be eligible for a Navy Supply Corps Foundation Scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a spouse, child, or grandchild of a living or deceased regular, retired, reserve or prior service Supply Corps officer.
- Be a spouse or child of an Active or Retired Enlisted with supply enlisted rating (e.g., AK, SK, MS/CS, SH, DK, LI, PC, LS).
- Attend a two (2) or four (4) year accredited college and must be a full-time undergraduate student. For Community College or Technical Schools, the School must be accredited, and the applicant must be a full-time student.
- Be an undergraduate student only.
- Attain a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 Scale.

- Spouse applicants must be enrolled for a minimum of 6 hours per semester, undergraduate only.
- Not be appointed, received, or accepted an official appointment to attend one of the service academies. Appointment or acceptance to a service academy will disqualify an applicant.

Scholarship Application Package

All applicants must submit a Scholarship Application that includes the information below. Failure to submit a complete application with the correct required information could result in disqualification and ineligibility for a scholarship. The Scholarship Application Package must include:

- Completed Scholarship Application (online)
- 2 Essays (online)
- Verification of Sponsor's eligibility
- Student Aid Report showing Expected Family Contribution amount from Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Official transcripts
- Letter of Recommendation
- NIB/NISH eligibility if applicable
- Signed Checklist
