The gift will allow NSCF to further its mission of providing programs and services to support the Navy Supply Corps Community and promote its heritage and traditions.

RADM (ret) Mike Lyden, NSCF Chairperson, welcomed the news. “We are extremely grateful to RADM St. Angelo and his wife Elizabeth for their outstanding philanthropy. One of the Foundation’s largest donors during his lifetime, this final gift exemplifies his true passion for the Supply Corps and an unrelenting drive to support the Foundation’s mission into the future.”

St. Angelo’s gift to the Foundation is one of the largest donations from a single individual in the organization’s history. St. Angelo and his wife Elizabeth dedicated their lives to their family, community, and the Navy Supply Corps. He was a longtime Foundation Board Member and made numerous contributions to better the Supply Corps Community.

St. Angelo served in the Navy Supply Corps from 1955-1990 and retired as a Rear Admiral. In 2008, he was named a Navy Supply Corps Foundation Distinguished Alumnus, recognized for his post-navy contributions which included a successful career in the investment banking business, starting at Dain, Kalman & Quail, Inc. of Minneapolis.

St. Angelo and his wife were two of the co-founders of Homeward Bound, Inc. a non-profit organization for the mentally handicapped. His support of people with special needs and his commitment to empowering their families with the resources needed, aligns with the values of the Foundation—emphasizing community, inclusion, and unity. More than ever, this generous gift to the Foundation will help provide greater opportunities to Supply Corps families throughout the world.
