



Minutes for NSCF Mechanicsburg Chapter Meeting 26 January 2018

- I. 1130: Call meeting to order, WSS Wardroom
 - II. CAPT Cassani opened the meeting by providing the following Foundation information. CDR Spencer Moseley is no longer the foundation webmaster due to health reasons; anyone interested in this position should notify the chapter board.
