



Minutes for NSCF, Mechanicsburg Chapter Meeting

- I. 1130: Call meeting to order, WSS Wardroom
- II. NSCF information (CAPT Yanero). CAPT Yanero discusses the Foundation phone call. A chapter was susceptible to the phishing scam that had chapter treasurers receive false emails from the president requesting money. One chapter fell for the scam and sent the requested money.
